



A person who accepts a caution or is convicted of a relevant offence for the purposes of the Vetting and Barring Scheme will be 'automatically' barred from working with children and/or vulnerable adults in regulated activity. Relevant offences are also known as autobar offences or automatic inclusion offences.

Depending on the offence, the person may be permitted to make representations to have them removed from a barred list.

Relevant Offences are set out in the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006 (Prescribed Criteria and Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 2009 and the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups (Prescribed Criteria and Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009.

The following lists for England/Wales and for Northern Ireland set out in plain English, the offences referred to in the above secondary legislation that will automatically bar a person from working or volunteering with children or vulnerable adults in *regulated activity*. The lists also set out whether representations will be permitted in relation to the bar.
